Lima's Famous Ginger Ale Gillette Bottling Works 1890-1916

Excerpt from
National Register of Historic Places Nomination Form:

"A long warehouse on Livingston Street was the location of the Gillette Bottling Works, begun by Schuyler Gillette about 1890. About 1893 Gillette invented a machine that could wash a case of 24 bottles at a time. The machine was built by the Bailey Engine Company in the same building as the soft drink factory and sold throughout the world. By 1916 Gillette had bought out his original two partners and had spent \$2000 perfecting his syrup for Gillette Ginger Ale. Gillette, who lived in the *Barnard Cobblestone House* at 7192 West Main Street, delivered his soft drinks to surrounding towns, Rochester drug stores, and leading New York City hotels and restaurants. When he died in 1916, his secret formula died with him and the business closed."
