Old Civil War period photos, letters, canteens, uniforms, diaries, musical instruments, guns, or any other artifacts that you might be willing to loan for secure inclusion for exhibit of Lima's role in the war?

In the March 2011 Yellow Wasp, Historian Douglas Morgan listed the names of 79 known individuals from Lima who had served in the Civil War. Many of the family names are familiar in Lima today. Although 150 years have passed, we suspect that some in our community may still have letters, diaries or other treasured artifacts from that period that have survived and been carefully passed down through the generations to present day family members. If possible, we would like to borrow some of those treasured items and include them in a new exhibit that will highlight the human role played by Lima families in that devastating four-year war.

Any items will be carefully secured in locked cases and kept under close supervision. The exhibit titled, "When Johnny Comes Marching Home Again," will be built around a family party for a Lima boy returning safely home from war. Clara Barton the Civil War Nurse

"Barton was never satisfied with remaining with medical units at the rear of the column-hours or even days away from a fight. At Antietam, she ordered the drivers of her supply wagons to follow the cannon and traveled all night, actually pulling ahead of military medical units. While the battle raged, she and her associates dashed about bringing relief and hope to the field. She nursed, comforted, and cooked for the wounded. In the face of danger, she wrote, 'I always tried . . . to succor the wounded until medical aid and supplies could come up. I could run the risk; it made no difference to anyone if I were shot or taken prisoner.'"
